


That same focus will remain a top priority for this year as well.



About Atmore Alabama


Atmore is a city located in Escambia County Alabama. It was incorporated in 1907, it was first recorded as William Station as a stop on the Mobile and Great Northern Railroad! Atmore began in the 1860s as a small town, and now has grown into the largest city in Escambia County. Just 50 miles north of Mobile and Pensacola, Atmore is perfectly positioned to be an attractive area for businesses while still retaining its warm and friendly charm! Named one of The Top 50 Safest Cities in Alabama in 2017, Atmore is home to passionate citizens and visionary leadership that are dedicated to revitalizing the city. This redevelopment has attracted new companies, brought in the next generation of workers and kept our current citizens happy. From discovering the shops on Main Street to marveling at the beauty of the Little River State Forest and Magnolia Branch Wildlife Reserve, Atmore holds a wealth of entertainment for residents and visitors alike. The City of Atmore is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for everyone by attracting a skilled workforce, local and regional businesses and higher paying jobs.

City Population & Race

Atmore is currently growing at a rate of **0.12%** annually but its population has decreased by **-10.45%** since the most recent census, which recorded a population of **10,194** in 2010. This deviation is due to the fact that the 2010 census included prison populations at Holman Prison and Fountain Prison, both located in Atmore, in its count. The 2020 census did not include the prison populations in data numbers.

Atmore reached its highest population of 10,169 in 2010. Spanning over 22 miles, Atmore has a population density of 418 people per square mile. The average household income in Atmore is \$38,383 with a poverty rate of 34.58%. The median rental costs in recent years comes to \$583 per month, and the median house value is \$94,300. The median age in Atmore is 38.4 years, 38.2 years for males, and 39.2 years for females.

Employment & Education

The graduation rate in Atmore is 90-94%. It is ranked in the ninety-first percentile for Alabama's graduation rate. Minority enrollment is 88% of the study body (minority Black), which is higher than Alabama's state average of 45%.

Atmore's employment rate is 27.5%. Unemployment rates are currently sitting at 15.7%. The City of Atmore boasts a competitive job market with careers with substantial pay. From 2018-2019, employment in Atmore, AL grew at a rate of 1.74% from 2.18K employees to 2.22k employees. The most common employment sectors for those who live in Atmore, AL are manufacturing (476 people), retail trade (392 people), and healthcare a& social assistance (281 people).





Greetings from the City of Atmore

The City of Atmore welcomes you! We are committed to creating an attractive community for newcomers, as well as our citizens. Stop by our Welcome Center to get a flavor for Atmore.

Proximity/Location

The City of Atmore has a unique advantage being within close proximity of Interstate 65, which provides a passageway to Gulf Coast beaches and is also part of the region's rapidly expanding aerospace corridor.

Workforce Development

Manufacturing and industrial activities in nearby Mobile improve economic development activity in our region, increasing the demand for a skilled, competitive workforce.

Coastal Alabama Community College serves Escambia, Baldwin, Monroe and Clarke counties. Coastal Alabama has begun a long-term expansion of the Atmore campus to offer technology courses that provide skilled labor to local industries. Phase One, currently under way, offers state-of-the-art machine tool equipment technology courses to support these industries. Phase Two involves design, construction, and upgrade of existing facilities to support workforce development efforts in Atmore and surrounding communities. Atmore will be able to provide a well-trained labor force within

commuting distance of these industrial facilities.

Escambia County High School offers career curriculum that includes culinary arts, a certified nursing assistant program, a cosmetology program, and a welding program. All these courses offer high school graduates the opportunity to enter the workforce after graduation. Escambia County Middle School's collaboration lab is in its fourth year. The STEM curriculum (science, technology, engineering and math) is included in this program.

New this year is the NAF Academy of IT. Coastal Alabama Community College will work to train dual-enrollment ECHS students in Information Technology, which is so in demand in today's world. The partnership enables students to earn an Associates Degree by the time they graduate from high school.

Downtown

Atmore's downtown is thriving! We have had several new retail businesses in the downtown district as well as other parts of the City, including three restaurants that are under construction (Jack's, Café 251 and Cajun Boiling Pot). Several upscale clothing and gift shops have opened, as well as some antique stores. The City continues to support downtown merchants.

In addition to unique retail shops and restaurants, and an active community theater, Pride of Atmore, whose goal is to revitalize downtown, continues to be very active. One of their major projects is renovation of the Strand Theater. Pride of Atmore holds fundraisers and is seeking grant opportunities to complete building restoration. The Pride of Atmore Organization/Strand Theatre Arts Center is a 501 (C)(3) non-profit organization whose main mission is to preserve and protect the historical legacy of Atmore. Bids have been awarded for a plan to renovate an adjacent downtown hardware store that will become a primary focal point for a multi-faceted Arts and Cultural Center to enhance the quality of life in Atmore and surrounding communities. Planned activities include concerts, lectures, and summer film programs for students.

The Alabama Small Business Development Center (www.AS-

BDC.org) assists small business start-ups with strategic planning, financing, and marketing. Local assistance to startup businesses through the Church Street incubator program provides space and guidance for new businesses. This initiative provides incentive to new businesses to locate in our downtown business corridor bringing more employment opportunities to our residents. More than 10,000 vehicles pass through Atmore on a daily basis. Our goal is to create a reason for these people to stop, shop, eat, and enjoy the arts and culture of our region.

Industrial

Within the City of Atmore, industries offer a diverse set of products and services, including those that manufacture and machine components used in the aerospace and medical industries, produce automotive parts, produce carpet, and metal fabrication. An \$80 million peanut shelling plant that will bring more than 100 jobs to the city and surrounding area, is also under construction. The new facility is expected to indirectly create at least 50 more jobs, as a trucking company and a bio-fuel plant have expressed interest in locating near the mill.

The City has secured federal and state funds for road improvements and municipal airport renovations, which make our downtown industrial park and Rivercane even more attractive to prospective industries. With recent renovations at the airport, our runway is now

5,025 feet in length. In order for insurance companies to allow jets to land, airport runways must have a minimum of 5,000 feet in length, which makes our airport more viable for business air travel. Grant opportunities continue to be sought to improve our roads and infrastructure.

Recreation

The City of Atmore has worked very hard to support the state of Alabama's health and wellness initiative. We are very proud of the improvements made to our city parks.

The city received grant funds from the ALProHealth program through Auburn University to purchase exercise equipment for both Tom Byrne and Hous-

ton Avery parks. This equipment provides aerobic workouts which can be used in conjunction with walking or running.

The city has completed a pool rehabilitation project at Houston Avery Park. This includes resurfacing the entire interior, retiling the pool border, and installing new drainage to save and improve water quality in both the pool and the kiddie pool. New playground equipment has been installed at Houston Avery Park for children two to five years of age.

Our parks have playground equipment; picnic areas with pavilions; well-lit walking paths; recently resurfaced, relined and repainted tennis courts at Houston Avery Park and Tom Byrne Park; tennis lessons; swimming pools; swimming lessons. Babe Ruth League Inc. includes Cal Ripken T-Ball for ages 4 through 6, Cal Ripken Baseball for ages 7 through 12, Babe Ruth Baseball for ages 13 through 18, and Babe Ruth Softball for ages 4 through 18.

Atmore Soccer has spring and fall soccer programs.

Through combined efforts of the Rotary Club, the Lions Club, Poarch Creek Indians, the City of Atmore and local businesses, Atmore's Heritage Park is home to a Splash Pad, which opened during the summer of 2018. During construction, the restrooms were upgraded in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) guidelines. A playground has been added next to the splash pad. The equipment was purchased through grant funds awarded

by Auburn University's ALPro-Health program.

Quality of Life for Seniors

The City of Atmore is committed to providing services to our senior citizens on a daily basis. These services have proven to be vital in keeping our older citizens independent. Two assisted living facilities (The Meadows and The Summit), one nursing home (Atmore Nursing Center) and the Atmore SAIL Center serve senior citizens in Atmore and its outlying areas.

The SAIL Center contributes in a positive way to the quality of life senior citizens enjoy, not only by providing meals, but by offering health education by various healthcare professionals, safety education and daily activities. Meals will again be available to seniors in the congregate meal setting once the COVID-19 virus runs its course or a vaccine is proven successful. Home-bound and drive-through delivery of meals has continued during the pandemic. Atmore has two vans which are

used for the transportation of senior citizens for social outings, health fairs and events with seniors from other areas.

As you can see from all of the activities, one of the essential components that make us great is community involvement and teamwork. Whether you are a resident, a visitor looking to relocate, or you're searching for a home for a potential business, we believe that you will find the City of Atmore has a lot to offer, and we are glad you are here!

Our History

Long before settlers came to the area that is now Atmore, the Creek Indians inhabited the virgin forests of longleaf pines, settling along the creeks and rivers. The development of this area began in the 1860s following the Civil War as the Mobile and Great Northern railroad extended its line south to the Ten-saw River near Mobile.

Workers who moved through the area laying track for the railroad were drawn by the rich farmland and abundance of timber. Agriculture and timber are still major factors in Atmore's economy.

The first structure in what is now Atmore was a small shed built along the railroad at which supplies were left for William Larkin Williams who had a logging operation ten miles down in Florida.

In 1866 the site was first

called Williams Station, just a supply stop along the railroad.

By the 1870s there were several buildings: a railroad station, a store containing the post office, and one dwelling. Late in 1870 the first sawmill was put into operation. However, it was the sawmill built by William Marshall Carney in 1876 that sparked the growth of the community.

Recognizing the potential of the area which abounded in cypress ponds and virgin forests, Mr. Carney (according to legend) hitched a mule to a boat and set claim to most of the area. Because of his many contributions to the growth of the community Mr. Carney is often called "The Father of Atmore."

By 1885 with a population of 195, Williams Station had enough residents to take an interest in politics. A polling place

was provided and votes were cast in a county election.

The W.M. Carney Mill Company was in full swing, attracting many settlers from Wilcox and Monroe counties who came to work in the lumber and turpentine industries. During this time the social life of Atmore centered on its early churches.

As the community grew, several leading citizens advanced the argument that the name Williams Station was not suitable for a thriving municipality of two hotels and a few stores. Carney was the most popular name, but there was already a small village just west of the town named Carney. In 1897, the name was changed to Atmore in honor of C.P. Atmore, the General Ticket Agent for the Louisville-Nashville Railroad which now crossed the river into Mobile.





THE STORY OF THE
POARCH BAND of CREEK INDIANS
IS A STORY OF SPIRIT, STRENGTH
AND PERSEVERANCE.



The harvest of corn ("vce") represents the beginning of a new year for Creek people.

The story of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians is a story of spirit, strength and perseverance. We have known extreme hardship, endured stereotypes and discrimination, and struggled to secure our land, educate our children, and maintain our culture and our traditions.

We have also realized great accomplishment and enjoyed sustained success, and today we stand as a federally-recognized sovereign nation, self-reliant and fully in control of our future.

Native Americans are an indigenous people, the original settlers of what is now the United States. The Poarch Band is descended from the powerful Creek Nation that resided in the southeastern coastal plain, primarily Alabama and Georgia.

But the Creek Indian War of 1813-14 forever changed our trajectory, dividing us and impacting the evolution of the Tribe.

The Treaty of Fort Jackson in 1814 further altered the legacy of the Creek Nation when more than 22 million acres of Creek land was, in effect, seized by the United States for white settlements. Subsequently, President Andrew Jackson pushed Congress in 1830 to pass the Indian Removal Act to ruthlessly clear Indian lands.

In what is known as the "Trail of Tears," the Creeks and other southeastern tribes were forcibly removed from their ancestral homes. It was an exceedingly dark moment in U.S. history as thousands died during the brutal and inhumane march of more than 1,000 miles.

But while some ancestors of the Poarch Band were forced to relocate, others stayed—with or without government approval. Aided by government land grants, a core group was able

to remain in Alabama and moved inland to the area around present-day Poarch, 50 miles northeast of Mobile.

We have now made our home in Poarch for over 200 years, our families at the heart of our lives.

Nature reveals that a single reed is fragile but, when reeds are woven together, there is strength. As the Poarch Band of Creek Indians, we are bound to each other by our past, our lives entwined, and together we are moving forward to secure our future. We are also bound to our beloved Alabama community—our friends and neighbors—as a major employer and benefactor for social programs, local events and charities.

It has been a long journey but together, with an enduring faith and resolve, we have persevered.



TRIBAL GOVERNMENT

The Tribe wields significant influence in the state, and is a very active player in the world of philanthropy. From the halls of the legislature to Congress to charitable foundations and organizations throughout the state, the Tribe is an economic and political powerhouse.

Service makes a community strong and is an essential mission of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians. Today we are led by a fully functional Tribal government that ensures Tribal Members have the services they require to not only survive but to thrive.

The Tribal government has established a strong infrastructure to provide quality education, housing and health care for Tribal Members and to promote public safety, in addition to other benefits.

The Tribal government also actively works to preserve our heritage and revive our native arts with regular activities to encourage and promote traditional dancing, language and other cultural learning.

Rather than building private wealth like most business entities, the Poarch Band of Creek Indians is growing assets for the good of the community. It is an American success story in the best sense.

Under the direction of the Tribal Council, our gaming and business development entities have been strategic in developments and acquisitions over the years. As of 2019, successful business ventures are being administered across a number of industries, including entertainment, hospitality, service and manufacturing. This portfolio has enabled the Tribe to attain not just self-sufficiency but prosperity.

On April 13, 1985, the Poarch Band of Creek Indians opened a 1,500-seat high-stakes bingo hall in rural Escambia County, Alabama. The Creek Bingo Palace immediately created 130 jobs in the small town of Atmore and set the Tribe on a path towards self-reliance and improved socio-economic standards.

"It has provided our rural community with jobs—both for our Tribal Members and for our neighbors," said former Tribal Chairman Buford L. Rolin. "It has allowed us to add to our community's tax base, and it has provided us opportunities to educate our children, build housing and medical clinics, and improve the lives of our elderly. Our gaming business has also provided us with capital that we have used to start other businesses."

As the Tribe's principal gaming and hospitality entity, Wind Creek Hospitality generates a sustainable revenue stream to fund the services provided by the Tribal government.

As of 2019, the Tribe operates three gaming facilities in Alabama: Wind Creek Casino & Hotel, Atmore; Wind Creek Casino & Hotel, Wetumpka; and Wind Creek Casino & Hotel, Montgomery. These destination resorts feature electronic

bingo games, stylish lodging, and casual and fine dining. Some locations offer a luxury spa. Wind Creek Casino & Hotel, Atmore, also offers family entertainment options such as a movie theater, bowling alley and arcade.

In addition, Wind Creek Hospitality owns two gaming properties in the Caribbean—the Renaissance Aruba Resort & Casino in Oranjestad, Aruba; the Renaissance Curaçao Resort and Casino in Willemstad, Curaçao. The most recent addition to the Wind Creek family is Wind Creek Bethlehem in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, and the Tribe hopes to expand the Wind Creek presence to the Chicago, Illinois area as well.

The Tribe also operates commercial racetracks in Alabama and Florida and manages the Wa She Shu casino in Nevada for the Washoe Tribe.

The Tribe's business portfolio extends well beyond the gaming industry, with expertise covering five market sectors—supporting operations and businesses in retail, tourism, hospitality, manufacturing and government services.

PCI Federal Services provides critical services to US Federal Agencies including the Department of Defense. They own and operate two aerospace companies that manufacture essential equipment for U.S. military aircraft as well as media

and communications, facilities, construction, business, manufacturing, and IT services.

“Our Tribe is extremely proud to support our nation's military aviation,” said PCI Aviation's CEO Mal McGhee. “We are ever mindful that each part we produce is critically important to ensuring that our military aircraft and the men and women who serve on them are effective and safe.”

In 2017, the Tribe ventured further into the hospitality industry with the opening of OWA, a top-class, family-friendly tourist destination

in Foley, Alabama. OWA means “water” in the Muskogee Creek language (originally spelled “ovv”) and refers to the 14-acre lake at the center of the unique project. It features a themed amusement park, a hotel and a wide selection of restaurants and shopping with a grand indoor water park opening soon.

Creek Indian Enterprises Development Authority operates many non-gaming businesses, as well, with multiple convenience stores and has partnerships with various hotels across the southeastern United States.

The relationship between Native Americans and those that came to our shores from abroad has frequently been contentious, especially in the early years of the U.S. But despite the decades of discrimination and injustice—even violence—against them, the Tribe has always fostered a desire for unity and reconciliation.


This desire has now been realized. With the growth and development of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians, the relationship between Alabama and its only federally recognized Tribe has deepened into a mutually beneficial partnership. And as the Tribe's economic impact on the state has increased, its influence has grown—from the halls of the

legislature to charitable foundations to leading organizations throughout the state.

The Tribe has also become a benevolent leader in the world of philanthropy. Given its long-standing tradition of sharing with those in need, the Tribe contributes to many charitable organizations in the community, helping to fund the arts as well as activities such as youth sports, senior care and emergency support services—a total of more than \$35 million since 2013. Its generosity also benefits the broader Alabama community through job creation. Tribal businesses alone accounted for nearly 9,000 direct jobs, over 90 percent of which are held by non-Indians.

Like reeds that have been woven together, we have survived the harsh winds of our history, emerging strong, successful and self-reliant.

Atmore is governed by a mayor and five-member city council which oversee the operations of the city and work in conjunction with other entities, such as the Chamber of Commerce, Poarch Band of Creek Indians and the Escambia County Commission, to improve and maintain the quality of life for our citizens. Council members also oversee the city's departments – Fire Department, Police Department, Atmore Municipal Airport, Streets and Beautification, Public Works, Cemeteries, and Parks and Recreation.

Mayor Jim Staff, a life-long resident of Atmore, is currently serving his fourth term. Prior to becoming Mayor, he served three consecutive terms as District 5 Council Member.

The governing body of Atmore is comprised of representatives of five districts. District 1 is represented by Webb Nall, who is serving his sixth council term. District 3 is represented by Councilman Eunice Johnson, who is serving her first term. District 4 Councilman Shawn Lassiter, who serves as Mayor Pro Tem, is also in his first term on the council, while District 5 Councilman Chris

Harrison is serving his third term in office, and District 2 Councilman Jerome Webster is serving his second term in office.

This Council brings more than fifty years of experience to the City of Atmore.

Several municipal offices are located in Atmore City Hall, including City Clerk, Revenue Department, Business Licenses, Building/Inspection/Permits and Code Enforcement.



We're All About Quality of Life

Atmore was one of the few cities in the Southeast chosen to participate in the Smart Growth America program. The Smart Growth America and USDA ongoing project began in 2019 and continues with high-energy inspired participants serving on various subcommittees who are committed to making Atmore a better place. Targeted goals include working to connect Rivercane to downtown Atmore; identifying ways to enhance downtown to attract more robust retail activity; better use of existing spaces and parking; saving existing historic businesses and buildings; and improving the city-wide image.

Atmore is now a part of the Main Street USA network. That organization works to create jobs for local residents and to help member communities establish and maintain their own character.

Rarely has anything captured the city's imagination so much as the opening of the splash pad at Heritage Park a couple of years ago. A true community and civic effort, the pad opened to the delight of countless local kids who found a good, safe way to cool off in the South Alabama heat. Amenities were added to make the time more enjoyable for the waiting adults as well. A playground was erected adjacent to the splash pad. Later, more playground equipment was installed, most of the equipment was covered, and shade trees were planted.

From Westside Park's enhanced basketball area, to Tom Byrne Park's exercise course (courtesy of ALProHealth), to improvements at Houston Avery Park, and with two pools and tennis courts, the city works to maintain recreation areas to encourage exercise and well-being for citizens. At Westside Park, the city has installed new benches and a covered shelter. Improvements at Houston Avery include new playground equipment, paved basketball courts, new goals, new benches and a renovated swimming pool.

Several Saturdays in the summer, you'll find the best in fresh, locally grown vegetables and

produce at the Farmers Market in Heritage Park. While the Farmers Market across from City Hall provides shoppers a chance to visit a few growers every day, the event in Heritage Park brings together a number of suppliers who "come to town" to sell everything from fruit and vegetables to canned goods to watermelons to green plants. Plans are to relocate the Farmers Market to the corner of Ridgeley and Trammell streets to make it more easily accessed by vendors and shoppers.


Atmore may be one of the few cities in which residents still feel safe to walk the city's sidewalks. Many walkers take advantage of the paved walking trails in Tom Byrne Park and Houston Avery Park, where lighting contributes to a sense of security. Also, grants have enabled the city to install sidewalks in residential areas to make walking to the parks more engaging.

The Atmore Public Library provides computers for its patrons and offers computer classes. Wi-Fi service is available, and mobile "hot spots" are available for loan. The children's section provides tablets with pre-loaded educational apps, and the library's children's reading programs are extremely popular.

Firefighters and police officers put their lives on the line to protect residents and their property. Atmore is fortunate to have a mutual aid agreement with surrounding city fire departments and volunteer fire departments. Members of the Atmore Police Department are often seen working shoulder to shoulder with Alabama State Troopers and Escambia County Sheriff's Office personnel.

The city's Public Works and Beautification departments keep the town looking nice. Each department goes the extra mile when we're having "company" for events such as Mayfest, Williams Station Day, Stomp the Yard and Unity in the Community.

In Atmore, it's not just about quality of life. It's about quality of life that enhances our lives while maintaining the community's small-town feeling.

Proudly holding the title of the first public school in the state of Alabama, Escambia County High School is located in Atmore. The 2021-2022 enrollment is 384 students in Grades 9 through 12. ECHS is the home of the Blue Devils, and along with other schools in the Escambia County System, offers a comprehensive instructional program providing students with both rigorous academic and extracurricular activities. Faculty and staff are committed to developing career and college ready graduates with the knowledge and skills to be successful in the 21st Century.

ECHS has its own career and technical school located on campus, offering a variety of opportunities to students including programs in culinary arts, welding, cosmetology, health science, ag science, business,



robotics, and information technology. The health science and welding programs are partnering with Coastal Alabama Community College to provide dual enrollment opportunities. All programs offer students avenues for earning industry certifications. The information technology program is part of the National Academy Foundation (NAF) offering students hands-on experiences and apprenticeships with local businesses. The academy is supported by an advisory board of local business partners committed to providing our students with resources for making their academy experience a success.

In addition to the career and technical programs and academic classes, ECHS offers other electives including Spanish, psychology, sociology, arts literacy, band, choir, and media production.

Huxford Elementary has 247 students in kindergarten through sixth grade. Principal Leah Fuqua said meeting the needs of those students is the main goal of the school's faculty, staff and administration.

Students who have issues with reading or math receive targeted intervention.

The rural school also has a chapter of the National Elementary Honor Society, which continues to have a strong impact throughout the school. Last year, the Huxford chapter boasted 44 members in grades 4 through 6, each of whom had to maintain an overall grade of 85 or higher, with no Ds or Fs in any class. This year's induction ceremony will be held late in the school year so that parents may attend.

Ms. Fuqua said parental involvement has increased, despite the COVID-19 pandemic, and the school has reactivated its Parent-Teacher Organization.

We are back open for face-to-face with business as normal. Field trips have resumed and our doors are back open for programs.

Ms. Fuqua said Huxford Elementary is benefiting from numerous partnerships. Among those are Atmore Area Chamber of Commerce, Poarch Creek Indians and Poarch Police Department, McCullough Christian Center, Renovation Ministries Church and RPM Ministries (Miss Flippy-toe).

Huxford is still without a gym or other indoor recreational facility, forcing students

to remain inside and watch movies when the weather is not conducive to outdoor activities. But Ms. Fuqua said it is the planning phase.

Rachel Patterson Elementary School has approximately 508 students in pre-k through third grades, plus 36 more students in the school's Head Start program for 3-year-olds and 4-year-olds.

Principal Toya McMillian is very pleased with the increased student enrollment during her two years as principal. The RPES Principal stated that great families are moving into the great city of Atmore and they could not be more honored to have the parents entrust the faculty and staff at RPES with their child's early education.

The administration, faculty, and staff at RPES are committed to serving the children of Atmore and providing them the best educational experience possible. Principal McMillian stated that her staff is dedicated to providing a program of excellence. Each day, they strive to educate the whole child by not only meeting their academic and behavioral needs, but by also meeting their basic needs. Principal McMillian stated that her and her staff believe that students must have Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs met before they can bloom and achieve, according to Bloom's Higher Order of Learning.

Principal McMillian indicated that through the help of many hands and partnerships, they are able to meet both of those needs by supplying their students in need with uniforms, jackets, shoes, supplies, etc. The school is also fortunate to have two local churches as partners in education to help fight childhood hunger through the Backpack Feeding Program where students receive enough meals on Fridays to last them through the weekend. The RPES Principal also stated they are in the process of purchasing a washer and dryer, so that they will be able to wash their students' uniforms and jackets during the school day.

Principal McMillian expressed how proud she is of her students and staff during these times of uncertainty. She stated everyone has been real troopers and her students have been resilient throughout the pandemic and dealing with COVID. Principal McMillian said in the last two years, several of their students have been impacted mentally and emotionally through the loss of a primary caregiver. To care for their students mentally and emotionally, the school has a full-time guidance counselor who provides counseling classes to all students on a weekly basis. The school also provides individual counseling services to students through a school-based counselor and Southwest Mental Health services. According to Principal McMillian, both counselors and the Southwest Mental Health therapist all work together to meet the needs of their students.

The RPES Principal stated that before they can educate their students, they have to be able to manage them. Last year, Principal McMillian re-implemented a Positive Behavior Program called "Perfect Pandas". The Perfect Pandas program is used to motivate and reward students

who behave appropriately. The RPES Principal stated that students are making tremendous growth in reading and math. According to Principal McMillian, the faculty and staff are working hard each day to close the academic gaps that were brought on by the pandemic. The RPES principal stated that they are proud of the gains they have made both last year and this year, but there is still much work to be done. In addition, they are also celebrating their students' gains and the hard work of the staff through several incentive-based programs.

Principal McMillian noted that there's something for everyone at RPES. The school now offers after-school tutoring through its Bridging the Gap program to help students in reading and math. The school also has a STEM program which is an advanced program for students who need a challenging curriculum in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. Art education is also a new program being offered to first through third graders this school year.

The RPES Principal said she is grateful for the continuous support of their students' parents and community stakeholders. Their school and students have benefited from several partnerships with individuals and entities outside the education community, including Atmore Municipal Court Judge Kaurean Reynolds, Mayor Jim Staff, Empowerment Tabernacle (Bishop Catadro North), Atmore Area Chamber of Commerce, Pepsi (Dale Ash), Poarch Band of Creek Indians/Wind Creek Casino, Walmart (Atmore), Atmore Police Department (Chief Chuck Brooks), Escambia County Sheriff's Office (Sheriff Heath Jackson), Atmore Fire Department, and numerous local churches and businesses. Parental support is at an all-time high, too, she added.

Principal McMillian described Rachel Patterson Elementary as a "small school with a big heart," and a "hidden treasure on the backstreet." She stated that amazing things are happening at RPES and she is looking forward to even greater things through prayer, hard work, and support from the community.
